WHAT IS AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER (ASD)?



- Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) is a developmental disability caused by differences in the brain.
- People with ASD may behave, communicate, interact, and learn in ways that are different from other people.
- All abilities vary significantly, and truly fall on a SPECTRUM

AUTISM & DROWNING

AUTISTIC CHILDREN ARE **160 TIMES** MORE
LIKELY TO DROWN THAN THEIR NEUROTYPICAL
PEERS,

DROWNING IS THE LEADING CAUSE OF DEATH FOR AUTISTIC CHILDREN.

DROWNING ACCOUNTS FOR **91%** OF DEATHS IN CHILDREN UNDER 14 WHO WANDER (AUTISM SOCIETY, 2024).



AUTISM & ELOPEMENT

Elopement: When an individual with autism leaves a safe area without supervision, posing safety risks. Common causes include sensory overload, seeking a preferred place, or lack of danger awareness (National Autism Association, CDC).

49% OF INDIVIDUALS WITH AUTISM WANDER FROM SAFE ENVIRONMENTS,

24% OF THOSE INDIVIDUALS HAVE EXPERIENCED A CLOSE CALL WITH DROWNING (AUTISM SOCIETY, 2024).

AUTISM ON THE WATER

Autistic individuals may be naturally drawn to water due to the sensory stimulation and the enjoyment it provides, including:

- Sound: Noise levels, echoes, or water splashing.
- Feeling: Temperature, texture, or movement in water.
- Visual: Reflections, waves, or changing light on water.
- **Buoyancy**: Floating sensation and body awareness in water.
- **Deep Pressure**: The calming effect of water resistance.



AUTISM ON THE WATER

AUTISTIC INDIVIDUALS MAY EXPERIENCE DIFFERENCES IN MUSCLE TONE, AFFECTING STRENGTH AND COORDINATION.





AUTISTIC INDIVIDUALS MAY BE SENSITIVE TO OR HAVE INCREASED INTERESTS IN SENSORY INPUTS FROM NOISE AND WATER

AUTISTIC INDIVIDUALS MAY BE MORE LIKELY TO WANDER FROM SAFE ENVIRONMENTS, INCREASING WATER-RELATED RISKS.

8:10 SAILOR RATIO

- Supervision is a key factor in preventing drowning.
- Eight trained adults supervise every ten sailors = constant supervision and immediate response if needed.
- Our team is trained in elopement
 prevention and uses clear boundaries,
 visual cues, and immediate response
 strategies to keep sailors safe.



CHILD-LED OPPORTUNITIES







We follow the child's lead with no pressure or expectations, allowing them to explore at their own comfort level while building confidence on the water through their interests and natural curiosity.

- Life Jackets Save Lives: 87% of drowning deaths in boating accidents occurred without a life jacket (U.S. Coast Guard, 2023)
