



Spectrum Sailing, 501(c)(3), is the only national Autism Sailing camp,

and was born out of necessity. When one father couldn't find a camp that would accommodate his autistic son, Spectrum Sailing was created to fill that gap. Spectrum Sailing has now grown to a national movement, giving autistic youth the change to thrive on the water.

HOW IT WORKS

Spectrum Sailing provides three-day sailing camps for autistic youth, ages 10-17, in cities across the country. During each camp, participants learn the fundamentals of sailing, including knot-tying, parts of the boat, why the boat sails, and, most importantly, how to sail! **Camp is 100% free to all participants, making Spectrum Sailing accessible to aspiring sailors from all backgrounds.**

Our programs are intentionally designed for autistic youth, using small groups and a sensory-friendly curriculum to help each sailor feel comfortable and supported. In this environment, participants have an opportunity to build confidence, develop new skills, and experience the freedom and joy of sailing.

OUR IMPACT

Sailing is our platform to positively impact the physical, mental, and social health of our participants. A recent study completed in partnership with George Washington University found that Spectrum Sailing programs improve confidence, teamwork, problem-solving, independence, and friendship-building skills.

Equally important, our camps strengthen local capacity. During each camp, we equip instructors and volunteers with practical tools for supporting autistic youth. These skills are brought back into the community, helping create a more inclusive and supportive environment year-round.
